Job Title : Post-Doctoral position-History, sociology, archaeology and anthropology of religions

Job Description :

The position is part of the Interdisciplinary Thematic Institute of History, Sociology, Archaeology and Anthropology of Religions (ITI HiSAAR) of the University of Strasbourg, whose objective is the critical study of religions through multidisciplinary collaboration in France, Europe and more widely internationally. The ITI HiSAAR's mission is to develop, on the one hand, interdisciplinary research in the field of the critical study of religious systems and, on the other hand, to provide university training through its HiSAAR University Diploma, which is open to master's and doctoral students and is composed of seminars, masterclasses and summer and winter universities.

The research and training of the ITI HiSAAR covers five axes: [1] Text, intertextuality and tradition, [2] Identities and alterities, [3] Religions and politics, [4] Ritual practices: gestures, objects and representations, [5] Sex, gender and religions.

Offer Requirements :

Within the framework of the ITI HiSAAR, the recruited person is expected to be strongly involved at several levels:

- Participate in the interdisciplinary research program proposed by the co-leaders of the 5 axes (round tables, study days, colloquiums).
- Participate in the interdisciplinary training program proposed by the co-leaders of the 5 axes (seminars, master classes, summer and winter universities).
- To carry out independent research in close collaboration with the ITI HiSAAR scientific leader and to organize international scientific events.
- To ensure the correspondence and the follow-up of ITI HiSAAR's publications with european publishing houses.

Eligibility criteria :

In order to complement the research and training areas of the ITI HiSAAR, this position is open to candidates with a university doctorate and specialists in pre-Islamic Iranian religions, notably the different currents of Mazdaism in their scriptural, ritual and social dimensions. Knowledge of the history of Mazdaism during the modern and contemporary periods is also required, as well as a good historiographical knowledge of European research in these fields (18th- 21st centuries). The candidate should also have knowledge of Avestic, Old Persian, and Middle Persian languages, be able to teach in English, and have experience in participating in international research programs.
