2. Research project and objectives

As part of its research aimed at the critical study of religions through interdisciplinary collaboration in France, Europe and more broadly internationally, ITI HiSAAR is offering one-year contracts throughout 2026 on a specific theme, falling within at least one of the four areas of research: [1] Text, intertextuality and tradition, [2] Identities and otherness, [3] Religions and politics, [4] Ritual practices: gestures, objects and representations.

The recruitment of a contract researcher aims to support the development of innovative scientific projects and is intended to be a rewarding step in the young researcher's career path in terms of

skills acquired, scientific autonomy and career prospects. This recruitment will strengthen the research activities of ITI HiSAAR, in particular by promoting interdisciplinary interactions. It also aims to contribute to research training through research, as well as to professionalisation, by involving the contract researcher in knowledge transfer, scientific organisation and supervision activities within the framework of ITI HiSAAR's university diploma programme.

The contract is for a period of one year, renewable if justified by the research needs and/or training activities carried out by the researcher within ITI.

3. Activities

Description of the research activities

The contract researcher undertakes to conduct a research project that falls within the scope of ITI HiSAAR's scientific activities. During the term of their contract, they are supervised by a reference researcher who holds an HDR (Habilitation à Diriger des Recherches) and is a member of this ITI.

The contract researcher is required to participate actively in the scientific life of ITI HiSAAR, in particular in the organisation of seminars, study days or colloquiums, the coordination of a journal section or the publication of proceedings of scientific events. He or she is also invited to publish articles presenting the results of his or her research.

Description of teaching and supervision activities

The contract researcher undertakes to participate actively in the activities of the ITI HiSAAR's university diploma programme, in particular in the organisation of seminars and workshops, the educational support of students, and the coordination or facilitation of certain training activities related to their field of research.

Presentation of the laboratory/unity:

The position is part of the Interdisciplinary Thematic Institute of History, Sociology, Archaeology and Anthropology of Religions (ITI HiSAAR) of the University of Strasbourg, whose objective is the critical study of religions through multidisciplinary collaboration in France, Europe and more widely internationally. The ITI HiSAAR's mission is to develop, on the one hand, interdisciplinary research in the field of the critical study of religious systems and, on the other hand, to provide university training through its HiSAAR University Diploma, which is open to master's and doctoral students and is composed of seminars, masterclasses and summer and winter universities.

The research and training of the ITI HiSAAR covers five axes: [1] Text, intertextuality and tradition, [2] Identities and alterities, [3] Religions and politics, [4] Ritual practices: gestures, objects and representations.

Once all the required documents have been submitted, candidates will receive an email inviting them to attend an interview on **February 17th 2026 between 2 and 7 p.m**.

The interview will last 20 minutes and will be structured as follows:

• 10 minutes project presentation

This high-level scientific presentation may be accompanied by a PowerPoint presentation if necessary.

• 10 minutes to answer questions or respond to comments.

The interview will be in French.
